Yellow duck compromises competition



A novel haemorrhagic virus has recently surfaced in Ramsgate, presenting as a new form of bleeding disease. The handling of individuals afflicted with the virus requires the use of hazmat suits due to its highly contagious nature, a rare occurrence in Africa.

The global decline in bee populations, loss of habitats, and shifting climate patterns raise concerns regarding governmental response.

Recent research indicates that while individual pesticides may offer agricultural benefits, their combined use can serve as neurotoxins, profoundly altering bee behaviour.

Bees are unable to detect whether or not there is a pesticide presence in nectar, demonstrating substantial exposure. Up to 90% of pollen and stream samples collected across the UK revealed pesticide contamination.

Asian hornets are experiencing an increase in size in the southern region of England. This escalation is of significant concern due to the inability of honey bees and Asian hornets to coexist.



A school armoury has been broken in to overnight in the basement of the school in between the bursary and library. The armoury is an alarmed room with reinforced walls an armoured door motion detectors.

The heist took place at 2.33 this morning, they used a series of smugglers tunnels then they broke through the floor using a breaching charge so they must be experienced so possibly trained by the military then they used a plasma cutter to cut out the stolen goods they were quick as it took 10 minutes.
